Trash bins are provided by Cal Met and trash is picked up every Monday except some holidays. ([www.calmetservices.com](http://www.calmetservices.com)) Trash cans should be set out after 6 p.m. Sunday night and brought in by end of day, Monday.

### \*\* PARKING IN SUNDANCE \*\*

Visitor parking spaces are limited and all streets are designated as 'fire lanes' by the City. Parking on our streets is only allowed to quickly load or unload a vehicle. Our patrol service is Patrol One at 714-541-0999 or [www.patrol-one.com](http://www.patrol-one.com). If you need a Permanent Parking Permit for additional vehicles registered to your unit, you may apply for a permit by completing a parking application and submitting it to Patrol One. There is a yearly fee and permits must be renewed annually. Should you need to park a vehicle overnight in guest parking that is not assigned a permanent parking permit, you must Safe-list the vehicle. This can be done by either calling Patrol One or going to their website [www.patrol-one.com](http://www.patrol-one.com). Put the confirmation number given on the dashboard of the car.
